In May 2007, Carilion held a one-time donation campaign to support the Virginia Tech community and to honor those lost in the April 16th tragedy, and raised \$37,342.33 from the project. In memory of those who lost their lives and also to honor their own employees for their commitment to care for those in need, Carilion has matched the funds raised by employees to make the total donation to Virginia Tech nearly \$75,000. With the University's guidance, the donations were used to create the Carilion VT Rescue Squad Endowment Fund. The endowment will be used to support the Virginia Tech Rescue Squad and help them continue to provide a high standard of care to their community.
